

Practical Matters and Rules of the Fair

It is important that you read the following practical matters and rules of the fair; You will forfeit your stall immediately if you do not strictly adhere to the following:

1. Entry to the site starts from 05:00. The trading hours, however, are strictly from 09:00 to 15:00. You may not start packing up your stall before 15:00. *No vehicles or trailers will be allowed in the trading area after 09:00 or before 15:00.* Transgressors will lose their stalls immediately.
2. Your stall will be issued to you permanently. You will forfeit your stall if you fail to attend two markets in a row without notifying us or if you do not pay for your stall.
3. We will be screening traders on the day of the Fair. Should we deem certain of your wares to be "not an antique or a collectable" we will request that you put them away. If you do not comply, you will forfeit your stall.
4. You may not share your stall with friends selling their goods from your stall. This is illegal as their goods have not been vetted.

Other:

- Although R15.00 will be charged for visitors parking, entry to the Voortrekker Monument Site is free if you are a trader or a Friend of the VTM. However, you **MUST** show your entrance sticker at the gate.
- Signposts will indicate the location of the trading area.
- You will be allowed to drive as close as the site allows to your stall to offload your goods. Since the space is limited, we request that you consider your fellow traders - once you have off-loaded your goods, please move your vehicle to the traders parking area immediately. To ensure that the process runs smoothly, officials will be on hand to direct you to your stall and off-loading areas. We will provide clearly marked day parking for all traders.
- You should arrange your own helpers to unpack / pack / fetch / carry.
- There will be visible security at the stalls.

What you may sell

We know that you understand the importance of preserving the character of the Fair. Therefore please bear the following in mind:

1. Only antiques and collectables are to be sold at the Antique Fair. We reserve the right to determine what may and may not be offered for sale. For example, flea market goods, crafting goods etc. are not permitted and stalls will be inspected regularly.
2. We will be screening goods at registration - this is why, on the registration form, we ask for the detail of what you intend selling on the day.
3. To ensure conformity table coverings are compulsory.

Other important notes

1. The stall fee is non-refundable under all circumstances and must be paid before every fair. If you do not pay for your stall you will lose it as we have a long waiting list.
2. The Voortrekker Monument Heritage Site and Nature Reserve and its personnel accept no responsibility for any loss or damage arising from or due to your participation in the Antique & Collectables Fair.
3. Right of admission is reserved.
